POLICY FOR THE PROHIBITION OF LIVE ANIMAL TESTING

The Board of Directors of COSTA BRAVA MEDITERRANEAN FOODS - Grup Cañigüeral, which has already signed the Animal Welfare Policy in force in the Group, as an extension also agrees to uphold the present policy aimed at determining that none of its companies has carried out tests or experiments on live animals throughout its history, and that this type of practice is expressly prohibited in the company's facilities and to its personnel from the present document onwards.

This requirement extends to all suppliers involved in livestock, whether on breeding farms, feedlots, or live animal transport companies, and all of them are asked to sign the animal welfare policy and our commercial policies (purchasing policy, anti-corruption policy, supplier code of ethics).

This policy does not have related objectives, as the number of experiments on live animals has always been and will always be zero. The responsible parties for ensuring that this remains the case are the management and sustainability committee and the direct managers of the Group's slaughterhouses, Frigoríficos Costa Brava (Riudellots) for pigs, and Fricafor (Vilafant) for cattle, who in any case will be aware of what this policy entails.
